With top Republicans such as Senator Mitch McConnell on the attack, veteran Congressman Charlie Rangel is in the hotseat for a number of alleged ethics violations, such as illicit use of rent controlled apartments and corporate sponsored jaunts to the Caribbean. The most serious of the charges is that after soliciting and receiving \$100,000 from Eugene Isenberg, CEO of Nabors Industries, for the Charles M. Rangel Foundation at the City University of New York, Rangel voted with the Republicans on the House Ways and Means Committee to approve a half a billion dollar tax break for Nabors Industries.
